PROTOCOLS FOR EMERGENCIES

“Intruder Response”

In the event of an emergency, Intruder Response may be called. School will go into a full lockdown of the school and surrounding area. Once the school responds to the threat, the local authorities are in charge and they will determine the information released to the public. Parents/guardians will receive a Blackboard Connect message when the situation is under control.

“Heightened Security”

In the event of an emergency, HEIGHTENED SECURITY may be called. A HEIGHTENED SECURITY prevents students from moving throughout the school to maintain accountability and is usually due to a medical condition of students/staff. HEIGHTENED SECURITY can also be in advisement of the local authorities due to the environmental conditions. Parent/guardian contact will be made through Blackboard Connect, if deemed necessary.

“EVACUATION PROCEDURES”

In the event we need to prepare to evacuate the building and school grounds, we will be asked to gather the students in one area to dismiss in an orderly fashion. Students may be transported to a central location at which parents will be notified to sign out their child(ren). Once the school conducts the Evacuation, the local authorities may be in charge and they may determine the information released to the public. Parents/guardians will receive a Blackboard Connect message when the situation is under control.
