As we begin to plan for the 2020-2021 school year, we want to notify you of an important change to the bell times in our District. These changes will allow us to maximize transportation resources and be proactive in addressing potential transportation challenges with the anticipated return to school this Fall. The bell times for the 2020-2021 school year are listed below:

The changes listed above reflect a change of 10-20 minutes at the elementary schools and LFHS. The most significant change for 2020-2021 is at W.T. Chipman Middle where bell times shift to 40 minutes earlier. We appreciate your understanding in advance as we adjust bell times for the upcoming year. Hopefully, communicating this information now will allow our stakeholders enough time to prepare.

We will follow our normal procedures of notification regarding the specific transportation details for your child as we approach the start of the 2020-2021 school year.
